



AUDIT COMMITTEE REPORT FOR THE TIME PERIOD

July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023

The financial data contained in the following financial statements for the time period of July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023 have been audited in detail by the Audit Committee members named below. These members agree that these financial statements are proper and correct, except for the following exceptions and/or recommendation:

- 1. Inventory losses/mislabeled
 - a. Due to loss of access to previous square account inventory data was lost. Based on reverse calculation 8 shirt cannot be accounted for. All remaining retail items could be verified.
- 2. Audit procedure recommendation:
 - a. Point 2: during summer reconciliation are presented at the first meeting of the school year
 - b. Point 5 and 17: No pe applicable.
 - Point 8: Not the current process, only one signer at this time. Audit committee recommending amending to two signers.
 - d. Point 16: Minutes show approval without motion, recommend motions be documented as well.
 - e. Point 17: Cash ledger being used, rec a cash form and two signatures for verification
 - f. Point 23: Sales tax form filed 10 days late and late fees were donated in cash
